



## Well Child Tamariki Ora Check



The complete suite of **Well Child Checks** (with the exception of the b4 School check) has replaced the Well Child 6-week check module. The suite includes the following forms:

- 6 week check
- 3 month check
- 5 month check
- 8-10 month check
- 12-24 month check
- 3 year check



These forms provide the opportunity to save a record of the Well Child check and relevant screening data into the PMS.

- Extracts information from your Practice Management System (PMS)
- Records PHO Performance Programme (PPP) compliant information (including smoking status and cessation codes) to your PMS
- Links with **Your Heart Forecast Tool**

## Patient Prompt new

The **Patient Prompt** reminds you at the time of consult if any:

- Reviews are due (CVD, diabetes etc.)
- Clinical data are missing (height, weight, blood pressure etc.)
- Clinical/lifestyle recommendations are appropriate (diet/exercise advice etc.)

Upon completion of the appropriate action, the reminder will be removed.

The Patient Prompt can be launched from the MedTech tool bar or set to open when the patient on the palette is changed.



## Adverse Drug Reaction

Need to advise CARM of an Adverse Drug Reaction? Do it electronically using *bestpractice* Decision Support. The **Adverse Drug Reaction** module is nationally funded and provided to General Practice at no cost. It assists by pulling the following data from your PMS:

- Current medications and vaccinations
- Patient details and medical history

Then you simply select the suspected medication and describe the adverse event.
